

Directions to Kitt Peak

Directions—

Kitt Peak is 56 miles southwest of Tucson on the Tohono O'Odham Reservation. Allow yourself 1.5 hour drive time. From central Tucson take I-10 to I-19 south. Less than 1 mile is Ajo Way/Hwy 86 (Exit 99). Take this west (right). Proceed past Ryan Airfield and Three Points/Robles Junction. Continue until junction 386 (Kitt Peak turnoff). Turn left on to scenic route 386. The Kitt Peak Visitor Center is located at the summit approximately 12 miles.

Public Facilities—

No food or gas facilities are available at Kitt Peak. Public restrooms are south of the parking lot. A wheelchair and handicap accessible restroom can be found in the Visitor Center. Picnic tables and grounds can be found on the mountain. No open fires of any kind are permitted. Temperatures on Kitt Peak are 10 to 20 degrees cooler (and windy) than in Tucson so please dress accordingly. Mountain elevation is 6,800 feet.
